New Business

Future fundraisers

Family night update – Kim Clark – Potbelly on 2/3 we will get 25% of all sales from 5-9pm – do not need to say that you are with GBN, we get 25% of all sales

Second annual Trivia night – January 23 – Bloomingdale Golf Club – cost \$25/person – theme is Hollywood. Swany has agreed to be MC again with Mike B, and he put together all questions already. We still need donations, need to set deadline for donations, of January 8, just before finals. We will put a note in the program – need mainly gift cards. We will put another flier in for the event and Mrs Johnson needs this earlier than the week of the concert.

Mike would like to making a donation to choir to defray cost of American Choir Director event, but Mrs. Johnson would like to wait until January, so we have a better idea of an amount to donate. Kids payments are done, hotel costs are what remain. Initiated discussion if boosters would contribute to part of the costs for these 6 GBN choir students chosen for honors choir. They will be going downtown for 3 days of rehearsal and performance. Wisconsin, IL, Iowa, Indiana and Michigan students participate – costs are registration (that the school has paid), and hotel – approximately \$40-50 per student per night. While this only benefits 6 kids, we have done things like this to benefit smaller groups in the past. These kids represent GBN and maybe will encourage others to audition. Not sure if there is a fee to attend, Mrs Johnson will find out. Diane moved to accept the move for boosters to contribute

to the costs of the American Choir Director event and Brenda seconded. Questions - Is there room in the budget? We think it will be about \$250 – band seems to receive much of the booster funds, so happy to offer to choir. We can limit, but have \$13,700 in our account, so this would not be too much to contribute – unanimous approval.
