October 14, 2014

Staff Reports;

Mr Burkemper shared that the Middle school festival this Thursday at 7pm, and he is in need of parents to help pass out programs. Mark Pierce volunteered.

Last football game is on October 24 and is senior night.

Fall band concert is on October 28- Concert band II will start, then marching band will perform.

IMEA last week Tuesday – 6 GBN students made the IMEA – Emily Park and Jesse Kuntz for band, Alyssa Kanturek and Michael Yurkiv for choir, Kyle Allison and Sarah Zhu for Orchestra

Laura Johnson reported that tomorrow night, October 14 the music boosters would like to provide pizza for women of note practice. A motion was made to purchase and provide pizza for this event, which was seconded and motion passed. Mrs. Johnson stated she expected about 115 girls.

October 21 is the fall choir concert.

Gold Tones will perform at St Mark's Episcopal Church on Saturday, October 18. First they will participate in a clinic with The 13 during the day at 2pm and then the concert is at 7pm – Cost for this concert is \$20 per person.

Fundraisers;

Cheesecake tasting Oct 22 – 6:45 delivery- a website blast will be sent to try to get 4 volunteer tasters- kids get 3 pieces of a 1/3 of each cheesecake piece – sales will end Nov 6. If orders come late, we have a long weekend after, so we could accept a few days later. Delivery will be on Nov 22 and will need volunteers to help distribute. Kathy Howe may have a half page flier to attach to the concert flier to give the details. Citrus fundraiser will run at the same time as the cheesecake fundraiser.

Tim Sherburne asked if we should have Fundraising transfer to Bob Rogers at any specific time – we will not have any in time for this Friday's first payment, but will look into having the numbers by the next payment in December. Julie Kanturek called Candace at Bob Rogers to confirm if they will apply fundraising credits and only charge credit cards the balance, and they will. Sing a thon and Play a thon fundraising dollars will come in slowly, so will have a cutoff date for when the money will be able to be given towards the Hawaii trip. Mrs. Johnson and Mr Burkemper will reach out to Bob Rogers Travel to determine dates of when the fund raisers should be rolled in, maybe before one or more of the payment dates. The initial deposit cannot be made with fundraisers, per the paperwork provided about the trip.

Cheese and candy fundraiser, some payments came in the form of coins, and we would like to try to make sure families do not do this in the future.

Approximate # of kids in music - 91 in choir, 170 in band

Hawaii trip – kids are still registering, even though the deadline was 10/10/14 – first deposit is due 10/17/14, which will be the final date to register.

Transactions – misc deposits, Market Day items all documented except for one check.

Payments – fliers for Zanies, yearly filing fee for Sec of State, pizza night, spirit wear deposit and one invoice paid, marching shoes. Tshirts will be here Wednesday and everything will arrive next week.

\$36,466.74 is the current balance.

Student accounts still have roll over balance, and no new fundraiser info has been loaded, as Tim just received it last night.

New cart has arrived– Mr. Burkemper will check on the invoice and give to Tim.

Trivia Night, moved date to Jan 31, from 6pm-10pm, \$20 ticket includes dinner, raffle ticket and trivia night and will be held at the Bloomingdale Golf Club. A save the date flier will be placed in the concert programs and we will start to sell tickets after the Zanies event.
